

**Pebblebrook Men's Golf Club**  
**Quarterly General Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday, October 15, 2019**

Meeting called to order by President Mark Gingrich at 8:30 AM.

- Introduction of Hall of Fame members.
- Acknowledgement of past Presidents.
- Thank you to Val Bennett and Mike Sproat (new member orientation).
- Discussion of fivesomes until course closures are over.
- MOTION MADE and approved to let Val have a free hand in determining the need for fivesomes.

Guest Speaker: Todd Patty, Environmental Services Manager

- Reviewed over-seeding schedule. Once courses re-open, golfers should ONLY drive in the rough while the Bermuda is still green. As the rough begins to go dormant, then drive carts ONLY IN FAIRWAYS.
- Water conservation demands are increasing. Reduced fall over-seeding helps conserve water. In the future, more acreage of grass will be converted to desert waste areas in courses like Grandview and Pebblebrook (currently wall-to-wall grass).
- Pebblebrook will close 5/26/2020 for renovations. The practice tee box will be flattened and doubled in size. Shoreline repairs on holes #8 and #18.
- In the discussion that followed, Todd Patty was vague whether or not new forward tee boxes will be added on seven holes during the Pebblebrook closure. The Board should follow up so this opportunity isn't wasted.
- Pebblebrook will see more stakes this season directing carts away from greens and greenside bunkers, and the rough. This effort should help the dormant rough not to deteriorate as quickly this season. However, if we see it destroyed like last year, a local rule could be adopted to allow for a free drop from bare dirt areas (treating as ground under repair).

Committee Report: Jim Anderson, Vice President:

- Jim represents us at the monthly Golf Council meetings. Email him if you have any concerns regarding Pebblebrook playability, weeds, and suggestions.
- Jim reported that we are in need of two new Board members for the upcoming year.

Committee Report: Dave Haen, Treasurer

- Membership through 9/30/2019 is 338 (325 was budgeted).
  - Membership in 2018 was 323.
  - In 2019, there were 53 non-renewals and 68 new members (+15 net).
- Treasurer's report is for the period 1/1/19 thru 9/30/19:
  - Cash balance on 9/30/19 is \$6,864.
  - YTD Revenue \$8,390.
  - YTD Expenses \$5,339.
  - YTD Operating Income \$3,051.
- We are on-budget YTD.

- Discussed local rule for out-of-bounds. Reminded players to laser distance to the green where the ball went OB and again when replacing the ball back in the fairway. IF YOU SIMPLY WALK A STRAIGHT LINE BACK TO THE FAIRWAY, YOU WILL BE CLOSER TO THE GREEN. Walk in an arc.

- MOTION MADE and approved to allow walkers at Pebblebrook during the remainder of the course closure/over-seeding season PROVIDED that there are no more than 5 teams of fivesomes.
