LWMGC Cup

The Laguna Woods Men's Golf Club is pleased to announce that the 2019 golfing year marks the first year of the LWMGC Cup. This year long Flight Competition begins in January and ends in December, highlighted by 7 Qualifying Competitions and culminating with 2 Championship Rounds.

Flights:

All Flights are to be determined by GHIN Index as of January 1, 2019. Each Player will remain in their assigned flight during the entire competition.

New Club Members admitted to the Club and wishing to participate will be assigned to their Flight according to their first appearance, with a valid GHIN Index, on the LWMGC Roster.

Nicklaus Flight: GHIN Index 0 to 14.3 - White Tees

Woods Flight: GHIN Index 14.4 to 22.4 - White Tees

Hagen Flight: GHIN Index 22.5 to 36.4 - Green Tees

Qualifying Format: Individual Stroke Play - Net Score - Stableford Format - Points Awarded in relation to a fixed score (NET PAR) at each hole as shown below. Stableford Points to be cumulative for each Qualifying Player in all Qualifying Round(s) regardless of the number of Qualifying Round(s) played. Qualifying is open to all members in good standing with a current GHIN index. **Players Current Index at the time of each Qualifying Round will be used for Scoring Purposes.**

Hole Played In	Points
More than one over NET PAR	0
One over NET PAR	1
NET PAR	2
One under NET PAR	4
Two under NET PAR	8
Three under NET PAR	16
Four under NET PAR	16

Requirements to Qualify for the Championship Round for each Flight:

1. Player must participate in a Minimum of 4 out of the 7 available Qualifying Competitions
AND
2. Player must accumulate enough Stableford Points within their assigned Flight as outlined here: The Championship Rounds will consist of the following Maximum Players by Flight.

In the event the Qualifying Competitions are limited to less than 7 available Qualifying Competitions; The Competition Committee reserves the right to determine the number of Minimum Competitions needed to Qualify for the Championship Rounds.

Nicklaus Flight: Finish within Top 30 Players at the end of Qualifying Rounds, including Ties

Woods Flight: Finish within Top 50 Players at the end of Qualifying Rounds, Including Ties

Hagen Flight: Finish within Top 50 Players at the end of Qualifying Rounds, Including Ties

Championship Format: Individual Stroke Play – Net Score – 2 (18 Hole) rounds Total Net Score

Championship Rounds are open to members; who have met the **Requirements to Qualify for the Championship Round for each Flight**, as noted above, and are in good standing with a current GHIN Index. **Players Current Index at the time of each Championship Round will be used for Scoring Purposes.**

The Championship Rounds will determine the Champion for each Flight, Lowest Cumulative Net Score Total; Both Rounds. Awards will be given for up to the fourth place finisher in each Flight.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to determine Tie Break procedure prior to the Championship Rounds. Notice to be given to the Players prior to start of play.

In the event of the Championship Rounds being limited to a single round; the Championship will be based on that round only.
