Good afternoon,

I hope the return to golf has been enjoyable so far. The weather has been wonderful, and the course is in great shape. I hope your swing wasn't too rusty!

After the first few days of play under the new guidelines, golf management staff will alter some procedures to serve you better while remaining compliant with social distancing requirements.

GOLF COURSES

- All residents must have a credit card on file.
- On-file gift cards will be used first to pay fees until value is exhausted.
- When taking reservations seven days in advance at 6:15 a.m., staff will capture only the caller's name and ID number. All other players in the group must call later to attach their names and IDs to the reservation.
- Times are charged individually unless otherwise directed.
- Green fees will be paid using on-file information the morning of play as they appear on the tee sheet; any changes must occur the night before.
- Cancellations must occur by the end of the previous business day.
- Arrive at the course no more than 10 minutes before your start time; report immediately to your assigned tee unless golf cart rental is necessary.
- Starters will confirm the resident cardholders are playing at the appropriate times.
- Golfers must maintain a 6-foot social distance at all times.
- Do not gather in parking lots before tee off or following play.
- Wear a face covering at all times until play begins; wear it upon finishing.
- Foam will take the place of course pins to prevent the ball from falling to the bottom. Retrieve the ball with two fingers. Do not touch the cup or the flagstick, and do not use your club or suction device (this damages the hole). The group determines when a ball is considered holed.

DRIVING RANGE

- Starting Wednesday, May 20, reservations are no longer required at the driving range.
- Practice mats are on a first-come first-served basis.
- Golfers must maintain a 6-foot social distance at all times.
- One \$3 bucket per person maximum; all others must sign a waiting list at the range shack.
- Wear a face covering at all times until you are on the range mat; wear it upon finishing.

Please note: Golf course staff has full authority to enforce all rules. Please do your part in following them to help ensure the golf courses and driving range can remain open.

Also, golfers may purchase select items through the golf shop and pick them up in front of the shop. Please email tom.mccray@vmsinc.org with the requested item(s), and it/they will be prepared for you to pick up. Please be specific when ordering, as all sales are final. Items will be charged to the card on file as soon as the order is placed.
