



The Ponds at Battle Creek

2017 League Championship

- This event is flighted, meaning you will only be competing with other players within your flight. Flights are computer generated based on your 18-hole handicap index. There are four flights of Open Players and one flight of the Champions/Senior Division.
- You must play both rounds at the specified time; no pre-play or make-ups.
 - Round one is at your regularly scheduled weekly tee time
 - **Round two** tee-times are with your flight based on round one results
 1. Championship Flight - 2:19pm – 2:55pm
 2. First Flight - 3:04pm – 3:31pm
 3. Champions/Senior Flight - 3:40pm – 4:43pm
 4. Second Flight - 4:52pm – 5:28pm
 5. Third Flight - 5:37pm – 6:04pm
 6. Leaders tee off last in each flight
- **SKINS:** There are two flights of skins. 1) Championship Flight plays a \$10 Gross skins game each round. 2) The First, Second, Third, and Senior Flights plays a SINGLE POOL (all flights combined) in Net ONLY each round.
- The Championship Flight is a “Gross” scores only event consisting of a combination of two nine-hole scores played from the black tees both rounds.
- Flights 1–3 is NET event consisting of a combination of two nine-hole scores played from the white tees both rounds. (Each player's nine-hole handicap is doubled creating one 18-hole handicap)
- You must play both rounds at the specified time; no pre-play or make-ups.
- **MAXIMUM SCORE ON ANY HOLE IS STILL A 9 (NINE)**
- **If play is suspended due to severe weather (one long horn will sound repeatedly)**, mark the location of your ball and return to the clubhouse. If three horns sound you need to return to the clubhouse immediately. If play is not resumed and all players of your Flight have not finished, full round play will be rescheduled.
- **USGA Rules apply.** (see local rules sheet) If there is a rules discrepancy, please play two balls and discuss the situation with the Rules Committee before signing your scorecard. Other issues--If you fail to putt out properly and don't correct the situation (with the correct procedure and penalty) before teeing off on the next hole, you will be disqualified.

The GIMME Tape IS IN PLAY for all flights BUT The CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT

- **Drop Areas** on holes 3, 4, 5, 7 & 9 are to be used only if your tee shot does not **clear** the hazard. Each drop area is clearly marked as a painted white circle in the grass on, or near the red tee markers.
- **Out of bounds-** defined by **WHITE stakes on holes 2, 3, 6, & 7.** If your ball goes out of bounds, you need to replay from the same place which the ball was hit out of bounds, with penalty of one stroke.
- **FIRST PLACE Ties** in ALL flights will be decided by a sudden death playoff starting on hole 1. If not decided by hole 9 or darkness, whichever comes first, the USGA scorecard playoff will be used.
- **Scorecards** PLEASE review your hole by hole scores after the round. ALL PLAYERS must sign the official score card. You are responsible for your hole-by-hole scores, **NOT the total.** The penalty for signing an incorrect scorecard can lead to disqualification.
