



## Wellshire Men's Golf Club 2017 Individual Match Play Tournament

- DATES:** Individual match play is to begin April 23, 2017. The dates for completion of each round are on the website (as empty brackets for now). Once the registration period is over, the brackets will be completed.
- Matches must be played head-to-head by the due date or both players will be disqualified, unless an exception is granted by the Match Play Director.
- TIME:** All matches must be played on the weekend unless agreed upon by all parties to be played during the week at a mutually acceptable time.
- COURSE:** We prefer individual matches be played at Wellshire Golf Course. **New for 2017** – if both participants agree, a match can be completed at another course.
- ENTRY DUE:** Friday, April 14, 2017. Pairings will be posted Wednesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>.
- CHAMPIONSHIP WEEKEND:** **Saturday, September 30<sup>th</sup> & Sunday, October 1<sup>st</sup>.**
- FORMAT:** The individual match play tournament has at least two flights, Championship (Scratch) and Net. All players tee off from either Bronze or Gold tees. If there are enough entries for additional net flights, there will be an "A", "B", "C", "D" net flight. The "A" flight will play from the Bronze tees and the rest of the flights will play from the Gold tees.
- HANDICAPS:** Use WMGC handicaps **posted** at the time of the match. WMGC handicap revisions shall be posted on the Men's Club bulletin board next to the GHIN computer. You may also review the current revisions on the website under the Handicaps tab.
- MATCH:** Net Match Handicaps will be established by wheeling off the low man in the match. For example: in a match with net handicaps of 10 and 15, the player with a 10-handicap will receive (0) strokes. The 15-handicap player will receive (5) strokes on the five lowest course handicap holes.
- PAYOUT:** Prize money will be awarded to the top four finishers in each flight.
- SCORING:** Use both first and last names on the scorecard. **Important: Once the match is decided – stop recording scores on the scorecard. Example: If the match ends on hole 15, no scores are posted on holes 16, 17, 18.** Handicap chairman will enter the scores on those holes after the match is over using the USGA system to finish scoring. All scorecards must be signed, attested, dated and left in the WMGC envelope tacked to the bulletin board near the GHIN computer.
- POSTING:** DO NOT post match play scores in the handicap computer. Handicap chairman will post all match play scores. You cannot advance to the next round of match play until your previous match has been officially recorded. Failure to comply with these scoring rules may result in disqualification.
