The maximum handicap index for both men and women will be 24.0. Any player with a handicap index of 24.1 and above will be allocated a 24.0 handicap index for the purpose of the event.

The Grand Final will take place between Saturday 2nd November to Thursday 7th November** in Turkey. The prize includes:
